D. Consider Resolution No. 2019-01, amending the 2018-2019 Crime Control and Prevention District's Budget in the amount of \$17,235.00 and authorizing the purchase of a 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe from the Crime Control Prevention District Fund.

Eric Foerster, Chief of Police, introduced the item. Background information is as follows: On May 4, 2019 while providing traffic control at an accident scene, unit #1503, a 2015 Chevrolet Tahoe, was struck by another vehicle and sustained damage to the frame. The Tahoe was subsequently totaled by TML, the City's insurance provider.

We are requesting funding for the emergency purchase of a replacement for unit #1503. The Police Department has located one of the few remaining 2019 Chevy Tahoe PPV's at Caldwell Country Chevrolet with HGAC pricing of \$32,860. Siddons Martin will outfit the new unit with the required equipment for \$6,850, bringing the total purchase price to \$39,710. The insurance settlement for unit #1503, currently in process by TML, will total \$22,475. The remainder of the funds, totaling \$17,235 are being requested from CCPD, which will in turn, be used to reimburse the City's General Fund.

The budget amendment moves the funds from the CCPD fund balance in to the CCPD Budget – Equipment Purchase Contribution – 50-27-9781 and is subject to the approval of the City Council.

With limited discussion on the matter, Board Member Singleton moved to approve Resolution No. 2019-01, amending the 2018-2019 Crime Control and Prevention District's Budget in the amount of \$17,235.00 and authorizing the purchase of a 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe from the Crime Control Prevention District Fund. Board Member Wubbenhorst seconded the motion. The vote follows:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In accordance with Sec. 363.204 (f) of the Local Government Code, the CCPD Board adopted the following procedures for adopting the annual budget:

- 1. <u>Public hearing before the Board required</u>. No later than the 21st day prior to the first month of each fiscal year of the District, the Board of Directors 'Board' shall hold a public hearing on the proposed annual budget for the upcoming fiscal year."
- 2. <u>Publication of time, date, and place of public hearing</u>. The Board shall publish notice of the time, date, and place of the public hearing on the proposed budget in a newspaper with general circulation in the District not later than the 7th day before the date of the hearing.
- 3. <u>Public hearing before the Board held</u>. At the public hearing conducted by the Board, all residents of the District are entitled to be present and participate in the hearing.
- 4. <u>Adoption of budget by the Board</u>. After the public hearing on the proposed budget, the Board shall adopt a budget for the upcoming fiscal year.
- 5. <u>Submission of budget to the City Council of the City of Jersey Village</u>. Within ten 10 days after the budget is adopted or deemed adopted by the Board, the Board shall submit the budget to the City Council of the City of Jersey Village, Texas the "City Council".
- 6. <u>Public hearing before the City Council required</u>. Not later than the 10th day prior to the first month of each fiscal year of the District, the City Council shall hold a public hearing on the budget adopted by the Board for the upcoming fiscal year.
- 7. <u>Publication of time, date, and place of public hearing</u>. The City Council shall publish notice of the time, date, and place of the public hearing on the budget adopted by the District in a newspaper with general circulation in the District not later than the 7th day before the date of the hearing.
- 8. <u>Public hearing before the City Council held</u>. At the public hearing conducted by the City Council of the City of Jersey Village, all residents of the District are entitled to be present and participate in the hearing.
- 9. <u>Approval of budget by the City Council</u>. After the public hearing on the District's budget, the City Council shall approve or reject the budget submitted by the Board. The City Council may not, on its own accord, amend the submitted budget. If the City Council rejects the submitted budget, the City Council and the Board shall meet and together approve a budget for the District.
- 10. <u>Amendment of the budget</u>. The Board may amend the District's budget after the beginning of the fiscal year with approval of the City Council.
