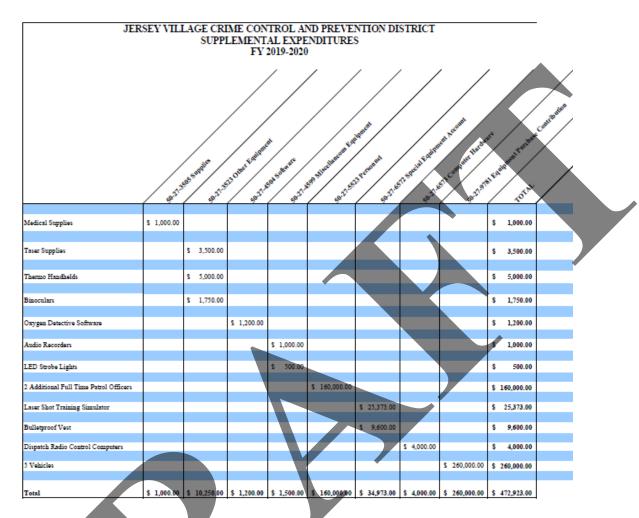

The Crime Control and Prevention District Board met on July 16, 2019 in a budget work session to review and discuss the proposed 2019-2020 budget.

After the meeting, it was discovered that several changes to the proposed budget are necessary before adopting the District's 2019-2020 budget.

The changes are as follows:

- <u>Increase the Tax Receipts Revenues line item 50-10-7623 by \$280,000 from \$1,625,000 to \$1,905,000.</u>
- <u>Increase the Personnel Cost line item 50-27-5523</u> by \$9,796 from \$1,155,427 to \$1,165,223.

Should the Crime Control and Prevention District Board desire to include these changes in the 2019-2020 proposed Crime Control and Prevention District's 2019-2020 Budget, the following motion has been prepared to accomplish the same.

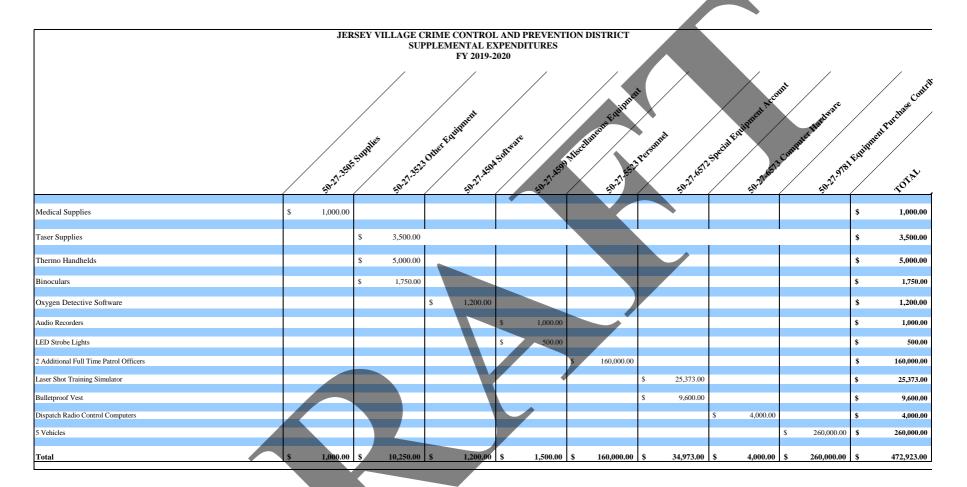

Section 1: That the Board hereby adopts the budget for the District's 2019-2020 fiscal year, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all intents and purposes.

Section 2: This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage by the Board.

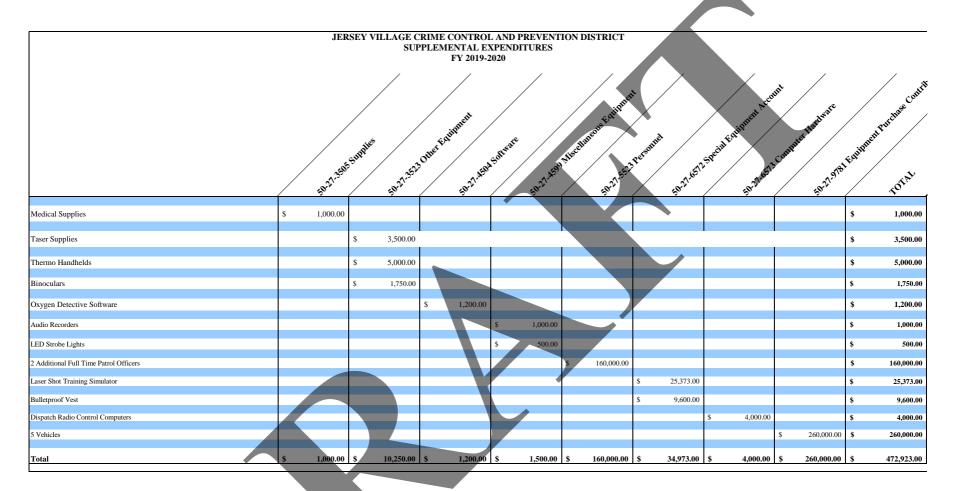
