The secretary need not be a director. The person who performs the duties of auditor for the political subdivision shall serve as treasurer for the district. Each officer of the board serves for a term of one year.

Accordingly, all officers of the CCPD will serve a term of one year beginning July 19, 2021 and ending July 18, 2022.

This item is to address the requirements of LGC Section 363.103.
