



The City of Jersey Village Long-term Flood Recovery Plan

Project Update

The Long-term Flood Recovery Plan project team has made significant progress since the last project update on November 16, 2016. The project team has made progress on several items that were included in the November update:

- Data collection from public agencies is nearing completion.
- The citizen questionnaire data has been compiled and converted into GIS format.
- Consideration and development of short-term and long-term alternatives is currently ongoing.
- The preliminary environmental review has been completed.
- The Rapid Assessment (Structural Inventory) of homes in the floodplain is ongoing and nearing completion.
- The existing conditions hydrologic and hydraulic analysis has begun.

Other tasks are not yet underway, such as the detailed analyses of alternatives, the economic analysis, and the final environmental review. Overall, the project is on schedule and making good progress toward the end goal: A hydraulically, economically, environmentally, and socially feasible Long-term Flood Recovery for the City of Jersey Village. The next project update will be posted in early January. Updates for the project will be posted monthly until the publication of the final plan.
